ISRD was set up in the year 1992 by a group of members from different background with a view to undertake various activities for the welfare of the society relating to health, education, environment and economic sustainability for the marginalized section of the society. It was registered as a Non-political Non-sectarian, Non-profit making and non-Governmental State level voluntary organization and registered under Manipur Societies Registration Act, 1989 and Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010.

Mission and Objectives

Objectives:

Management

Organisation: ISRD is managed by a Managing Committee having 5 members headed by the President elected by members of general body of the Organization. The Committee meets once in every month. All the decisions are unanimously taken in Executive body of the Organization.

Financial: Financial Management Consists of Book Keeping & Record Maintenance, Internal Controls & Checks, Planning & Budgeting, Reporting, Statutory Compliances and asset disposition plan. Our financial auditing process conducted by internal audit committee and externally by a registered Chartered Accountant annually.

Internal Controls: Procurement Policy, Anti-Bribery and Anti-Corruption Policy of the organization covers Bribes, Gifts and hospitality, Facilitation payments, Political contributions and charitable contributions which periodically assess by a Committee.

Focus areas: We are working to meet Sustainable Development Soals
















Overview of Expenses
